**(b):** In each odd-numbered year three (3) council members and a Mayor shall be elected and in each even-numbered year three (3) council members shall be elected; **(c)** The Mayor and other members of the Council shall be elected from the Town at large, for a term of two (2) years; and **(h)** No person shall serve as Mayor for more than three (3) successive terms of office, and no person shall serve as a council member for more than three (3) successive terms of office.

**CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & DEADLINE TO FILE**

<b>Candidate Eligibility Requirements</b>	<b>Deadline to File Candidate Application</b>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be 18 years of age or older on the day of the election.</li> <li>Be a citizen of the United States.</li> <li>Not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be: (a) totally mentally incapacitated; or (b) partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.</li> <li>Not have been finally convicted of a felony or, if so convicted, must have: (a) fully discharged the sentence, including any term of incarceration, parole, or supervision, or completed a period of probation ordered by any court; or (b) been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disability to vote.</li> <li>Be a Resident of the city for at least 12 months.</li> <li>Be a registered voter on the day of the election.</li> <li>Submission of nomination petition. [link to petition] Candidates may become a candidate for Mayor or City Council by petition only, per City Charter:</li> <li>Application and Petition must be filed together by the filing deadline:</li> <li>Candidate Packets, including the application and petition are available in the City Secretary's Office the first week of January each year.</li> </ol> <p><b>Candidates are strongly encouraged to obtain a candidate</b></p>	<p align="center">Friday, February 16, 2024 by 5:00 pm</p> <p align="center"><i>The filing period begins on the 108<sup>th</sup> day prior to the election date and ends on the 78<sup>th</sup> day at 5 p.m. prior to the election date.</i></p>
